Please be careful when you will be free. Please, Pegah, be cautious: we are ready to protect you, though we are actually far from you. Your life is holy, you are a living symbol of the divine purity of the womankind. It's necessary for you to constantly preserve your life with prudence, and accept help from your friends. Please do love your life also in our name and behalf, even when you are deeply sad. You have undergone all kinds of persecutions but you never surrendered yourself. No other words can make you feel how precious and beloved and respected you are to us.

We are, with your permission, your sister and your brother, our home is yours, your dignity and freedom are our dignity and freedom.

We are humbly part of EveryOne Group led and run by an Italian Hero, Roberto Malini, fighting together with God for your freedom: very soon you shall be free forever.
